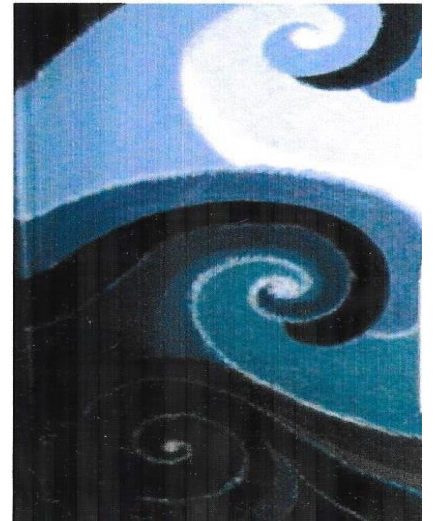
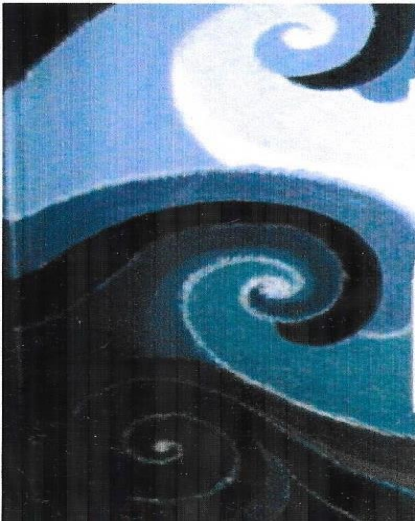

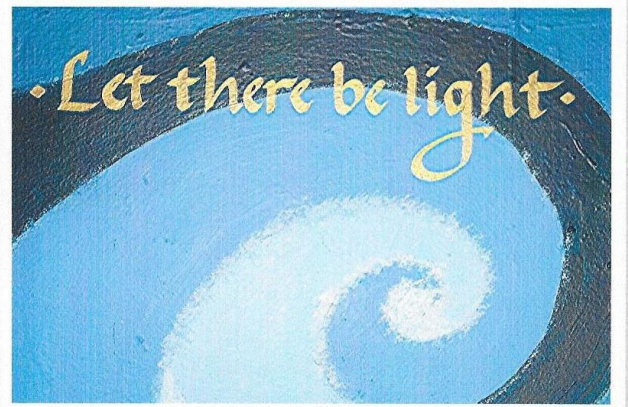


And God said

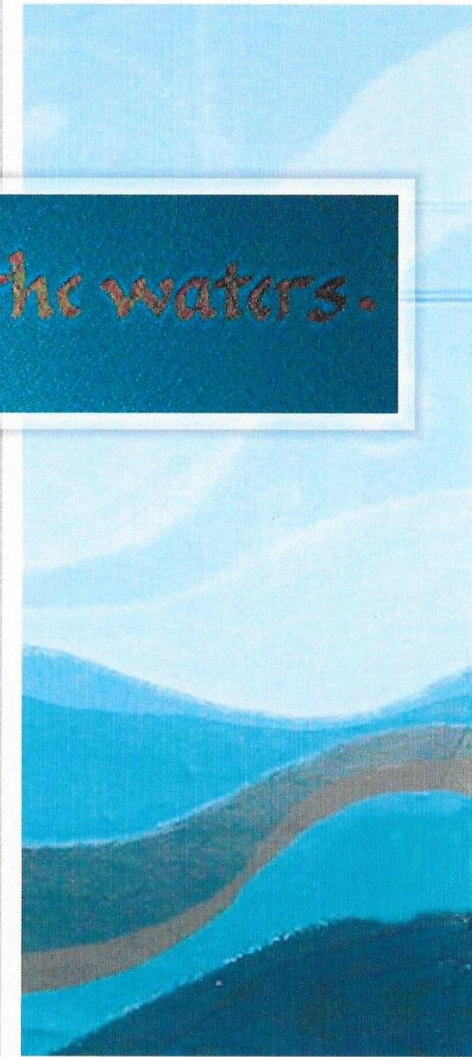


The first day

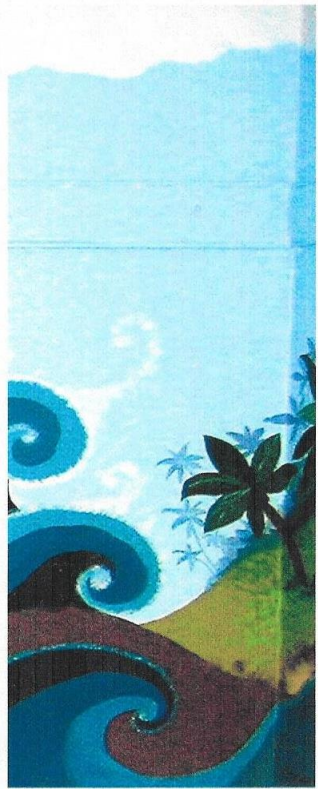
The second day

So God made the vault and separated the water under the vault from the water above it. And it was so. God called the vault “sky.” And there was evening, and there was morning—the second day.

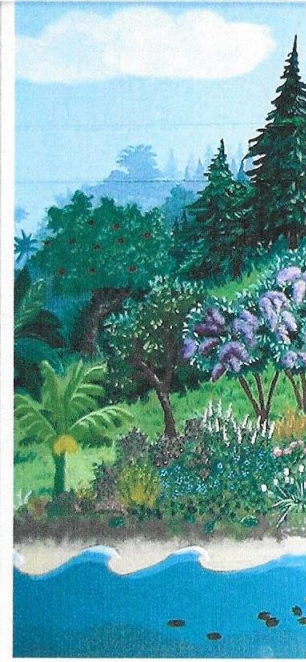


Let the water be gathered to one place, and let dry ground appear.

The third day

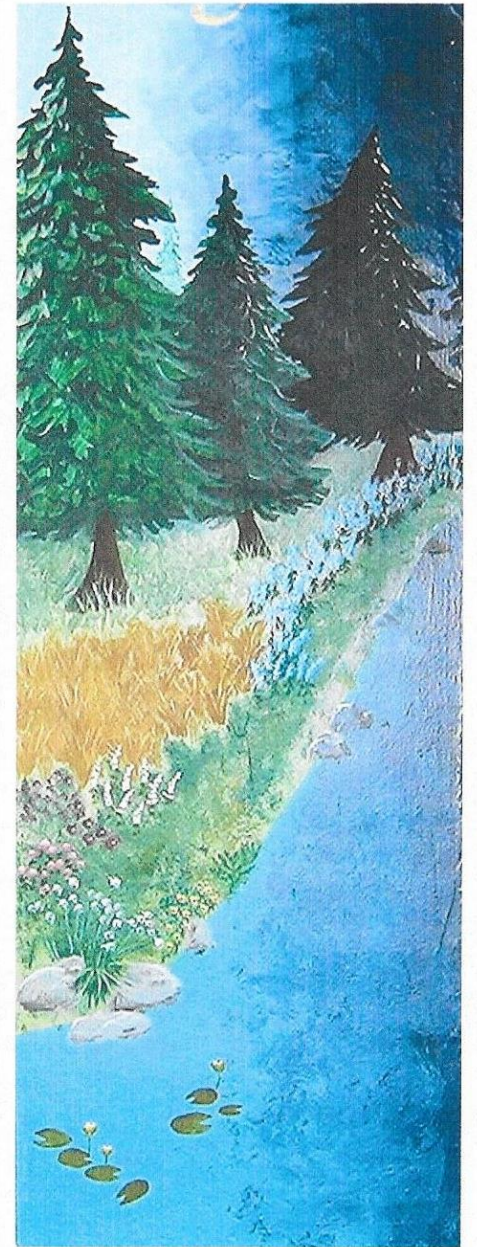


...Plants bearing seed

was good.

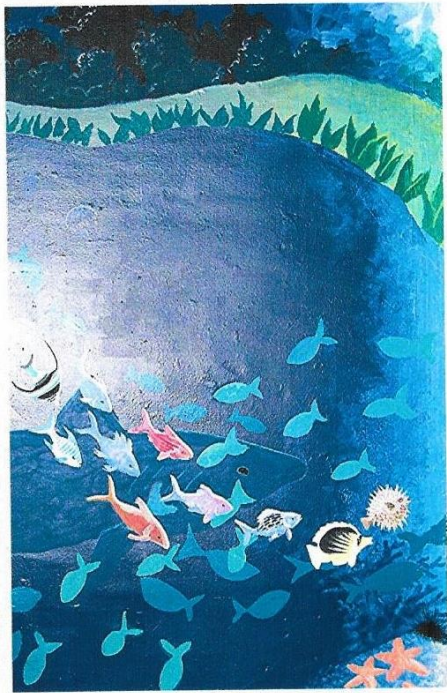


God made two great lights

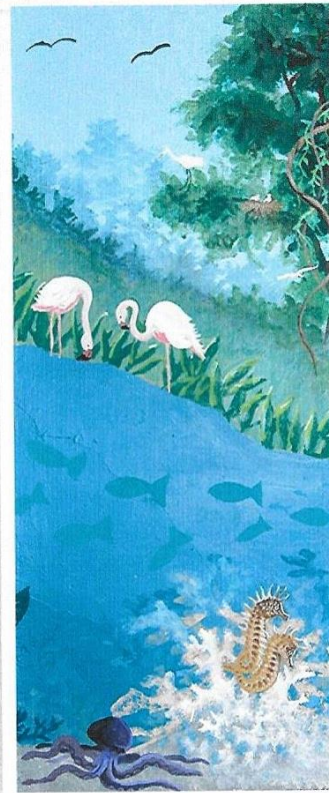
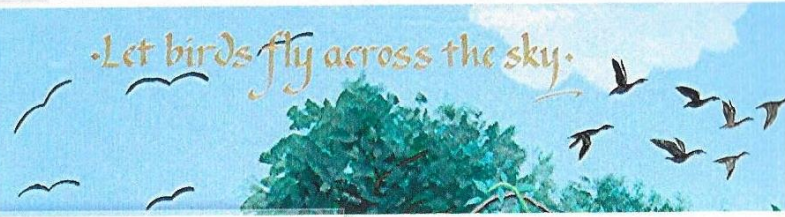


• Let the water teem with living creatures.



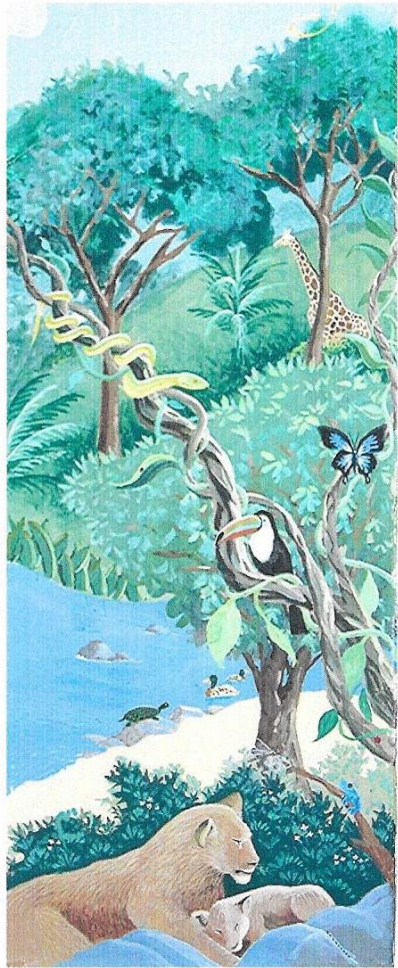
The fifth day

• Let birds fly across the sky.



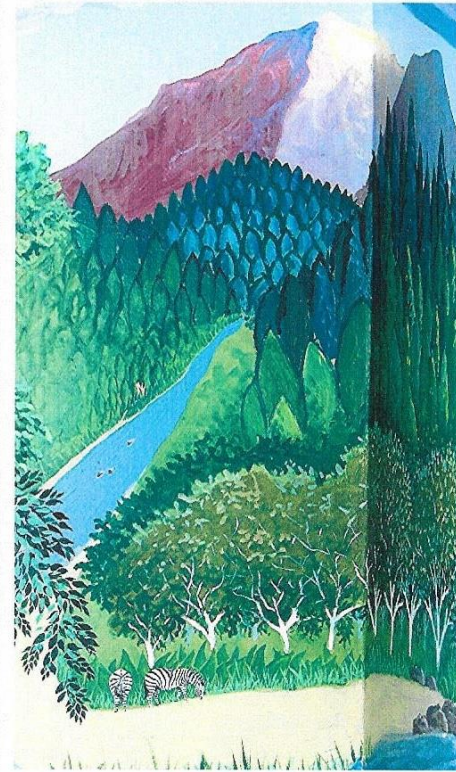
God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the water in the seas, and let the birds increase on the earth."

•Let us make man in our image.

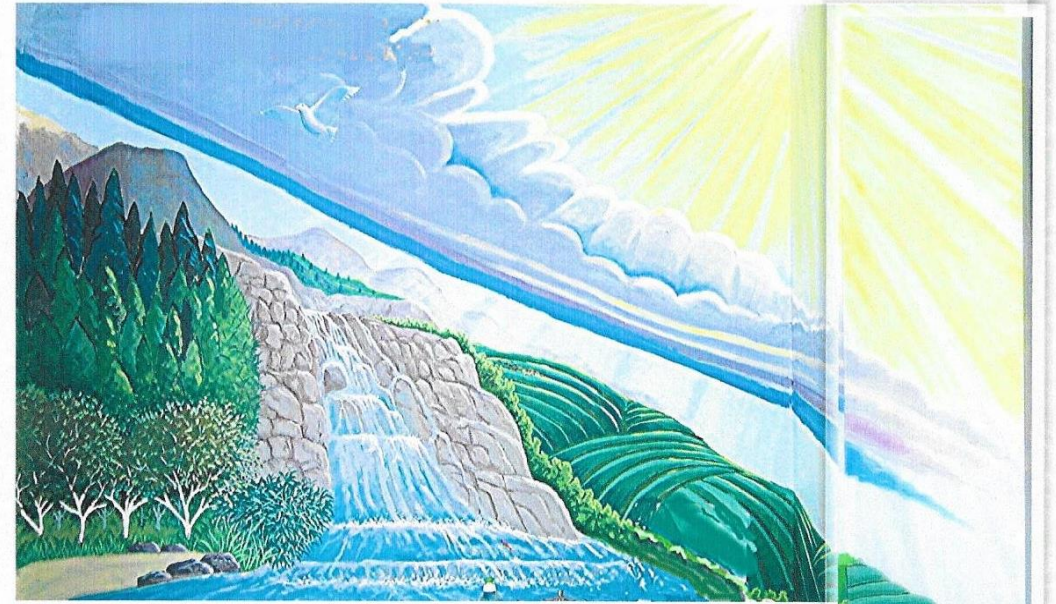
The sixth day
