Christ. Amen.

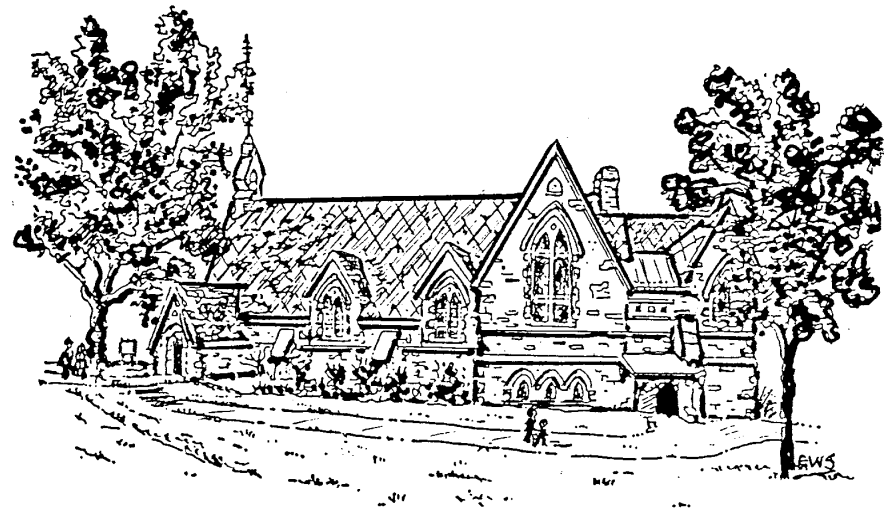
