Preface: On September 3, we began a pilot project that combines the 9:15 am & 11 am services into one 10:30 am service. The early service was moved to 8:30 am to provide an alternative. The plan was to experience the combined services for three months and then make an informed decision in December about how we would move forward in January.

However, it has become apparent that we are not ready to make that decision. For one thing we are still in the process of figuring out things around music and we have become increasingly aware that, until recently, folks had not realized the monthly pattern of worship. So, to give this experience a fair go, we will be extending the pilot to vestry (February). In the mean time we would continue our conversation on Sunday, December 3 following the 10:30 am service (start time around 11:45 am).
