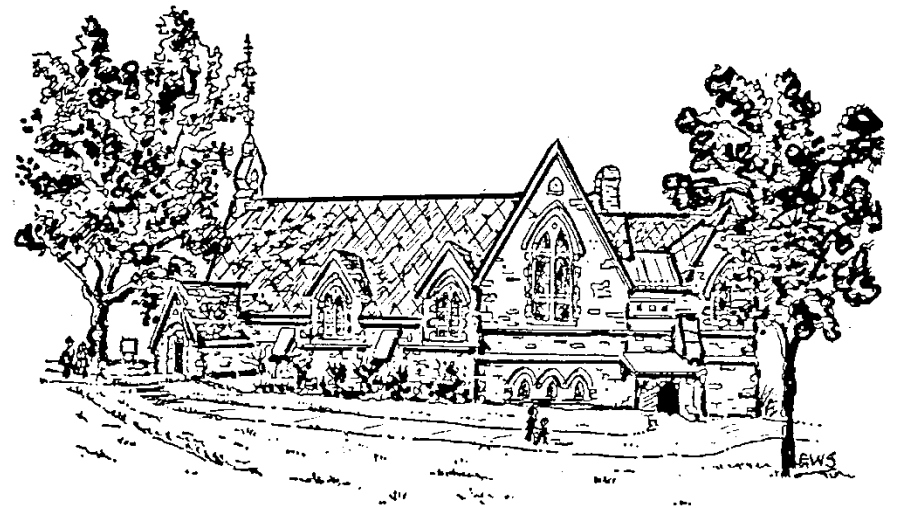
**In Our Parish Cycle of Prayer:** We pray for Bev Madden, Barbara Maguire, Claire Marson and, Tash & Lhotse Masson.
