**Tuesday July 3:** work on Phase II will begin. The Hall will be emptied of everything on the floor (except the bookcases).

**Friday July 6:**, existing carpets in the church will be professionally removed.

**Sunday, July 8:** after the 10:30 service on the church will be totally stripped of all chairs and pews, all hangings, all brass, everything!

**Monday, July 9:** hardwood sanding/ buffing and refinishing of both church and hall will begin.
