At the end of the 10:30 a.m. service today ALL remaining items on the floor must be removed, with only a few exceptions. Bob Bassett will direct this activity. Your help would be greatly appreciated!

Many hands will distribute the load, and allow this to flow smoothly. Thanks in advance for your practical support!

Monday, July 9: hardwood sanding/ buffing and refinishing of both church and hall will begin. (by professionals)

****Church and Hall will both be "out of bounds" for the entire week****

Sunday July 15 & Sunday July 22: Regular 8:30 a.m. service will be held in the Hall (basement) and the 10:30 service will be held outdoors or in the Hall, if wet.

****WARNING – The smell of fumes from drying varathane is very likely in the Hall on the 15th – WARNING ****

Monday July 23: carpeting installation (by professionals) begins in the church for 2-3 days. After completion of the carpeting, the church will be "put back together" (by volunteers).

What about the church services for the next few weeks? Worshipping at St Paul's will continue as it has for over 150 years, with only minor adjustments required. Your patience and co-operation are appreciated.

What about July 15 and 22nd services? Both 8:30 and 10:30 will most likely take place in the Church Hall (basement). It is generally cooler there, and the smell of drying varathane will be less as they will refinish this area first. Those with particular sensitivities to odours, please note!

How long will we be out of our beautiful worship space? If all goes as planned, and weather and workmen's schedules do not complicate, carpeting installation will begin on Monday July 23rd for 2-3 days. After completion of the carpeting, the church will be "put back together".
