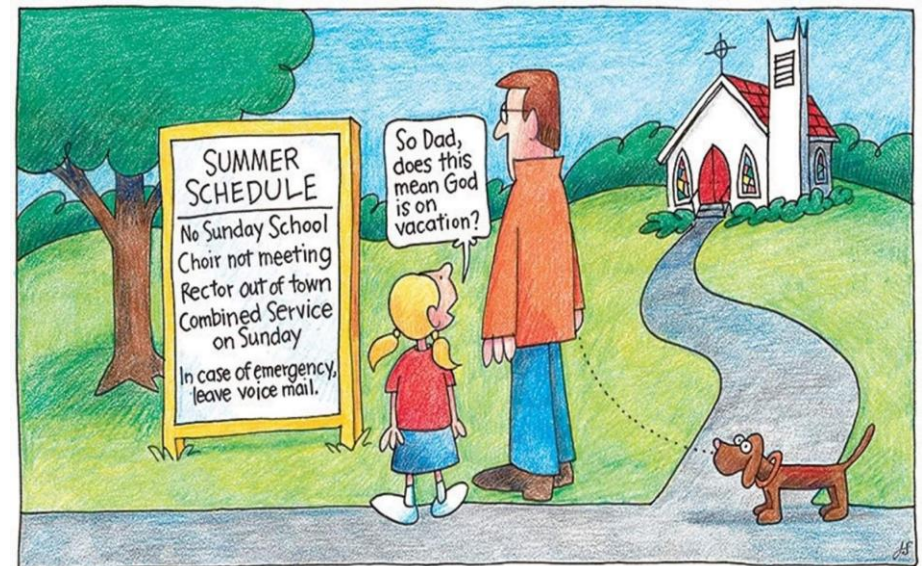


STRAWBERRY SOCIAL & BAKE SALE in support of Fairview Manor.
