All: God our Father, we are sorry for the times when we have used your gifts carelessly, and acted ungratefully.

Hear our prayer, and in your mercy: forgive us and help us. Amen.

Celebrant: The Lord be with you

Celebrant: Lift up your hearts

All: We lift them to the Lord

All: It is right to give our thanks and praise

Celebrant: Father almighty, creator of all, it is indeed right to bring you thanks and praise, all year round. Your glory is made known in the beauty and wonder all around us. Your amazing love is seen in the bounteous providence of nature.

You have spoken, and this world came into being - bursting with life.

For the fruits of his creation, **All:** Thanks be to God.

Celebrant: Everlasting God, sower of the Word, You have spoken to your people in season and out of season: through prophets, priests and kings, through holy families and faithful saints. Your Word has been our nourishment throughout the ages,

like honey to the lips. And supremely, tangibly and comprehensibly, you have spoken through your Son, the Saviour of the World.

Celebrant: King of the heavens, grower of the Vine, we thank you that Jesus lived among us: walking with his friends as they plucked grain from the wayside, breaking bread with the hungry on a hillside, overseeing a great harvest of fish at the lakeside. Celebrant: You have made us stewards of your creation, to praise you day by day for the marvels of your wisdom and power: so earth unites with heaven to sing the new song of creation: **All:** Thanks be to God.
