Dear Friends,

Good news! We will be resuming in-person Church services at St. Paul's, outdoors, this coming Sunday, July 11 at 9:30 a.m.

After fifteen months of not being able to worship together, the province and our diocese are now allowing limited in-person Church services. Please note the following details:

- The service will be outdoors on our lawn in front of the stone altar, **beginning at 9:30 a.m.**
- **Masking and physical distancing will still be required.**
- **Please bring your own lawn chair.** You may also want to bring a sun hat (although there is adequate shade from the trees), bug spray, and water.
- You will still need to sign in for contact tracing, although pre-registration will no longer be required.
- The service will be a combined liturgy from the Book of Common Prayer and the Book of Alternative Services, as we have been doing. Service sheets will be provided for you to follow along.
- Communion will be served, but it will be bread only.
- **In case of rain we will move indoors, although the seating limit indoors (set by the province) is 30 people.**
- The service will still be recorded and uploaded to YouTube for those who wish to worship from home.

We will try out this new format for the remainder of the summer, moving to indoor services in September. We are unable to hold services downstairs in the Church hall as in previous summers because the seating limit with physical distancing in that space would only be about 10-15 people.

We hope to see you on Sunday, if you feel safe and comfortable joining us.
